Industrial/Organizational Psychology Majors are in a terrific position to achieve the Leadership Minor within the 120 credit-hour requirement for a degree. However, advisors and students need to plan out courses very carefully because these two fields are so closely related. Although you will be taking courses that would normally count for the minor in several areas below, we are limited to double-dipping just two courses (the Introductory and Capstone courses) because of university rules.
