2 Ethnicity is determined using the IPEDs definitions.

3 Graduation rates are based on the date the first bachelor degree is conferred for each student. Per the IPEDs definition a student cannot be included in the graduation rate until the degree has been conferred. Some multiple level programs do not earn the bachelor's until some point during the graduate or professional work. This rate is calculated using degrees conferred during the entire academic year, from September through August for the given year.

4 Financial Aid Category is based on Financial Aid accepted by the student in the Fall 2011 term. This does not indicate that a student was not offered federal loan funds.
