This guide reflects the New Core Curriculum effective Fall 2017. Transfer students starting at Detroit Mercy between Fall 2017 and Summer 2021 will have the option to select this New Core or the Old Core. See Transfer Guides indicating "OLD CORE" for prior Core requirements.

The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy's Architecture program. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree; course grades must be a 2.0 or better. Additional courses not on this guide may also transfer. Generally, a 3.0 GPA at Schoolcraft is necessary for admission. We encourage you to meet with a Detroit Mercy School of Architecture administrator to discuss individual curriculum plans.
