The Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program has 5 learning outcomes. One outcome is evaluated yearly. Faculty assess learning outcomes using signature assignments primarily in theory courses as well as assignments that are initiated in clinical courses, but then graded in a concurrent didactic course. Instructors who teach the courses upload the signature assignment outcomes data to a TEAMs folder. Data is reviewed by the Outcomes Coordinator and/or the Program coordinator.

Any recommendations for change based on assessment feedback are provided to the Undergraduate Faculty by the Curriculum committee and the Assessment & Achievement of Outcomes Committee (AAOC) for decision making specific to program improvements.

4. Student Learning Outcomes -Which student learning outcome(s) from the assessment plan filed with the University Assessment Team is/are being reported on in this report? Include the corresponding benchmark(s) for each outcome.

Referring to the Program Assessment Plans on file with the University Assessment Team, student learning outcome #1 is being assessed in this cycle.

Outcomes #1: Apply Mercy-Jesuit values, professional behaviors and attributes into nursing care while developing resiliency and fostering self-care to support personal well-being, a commitment to lifelong learning and leadership in the nursing profession.

Students demonstrate achievement of this outcome through a signature assignment/final paper in NUR 2100 (BSN & SDO programs) and by a signature assignment/final project in NUR 3251 (BSNc).

The benchmark for success for this outcome is that 85% of the students will earn 85% or better on the signature assignment.

To assess achievement of this outcome students completed a signature assignment.

SDO:

- Fall 2023 100% of students achieved benchmark.
- Fall 2024 93% of students achieved benchmark.

BSN:

- Winter 24 (Grand Rapids). 65% of students scored 85% or higher.
- Fall 2024 (McNichols). 80% of students scored 85% or higher.

BSNc

• Fall 2024 100% of students achieved benchmark.

A requirement of the signature assignment was adherence to APA writing standards which may negatively impact scores. The faculty will vote on using the course group presentation assignment rather than a paper to assess outcome achievement. This outcome will be reassessed next year.
