COLLEGE OF HEALTH PROFESSIONS HEALTH SERVICES ADMINISTRATION

The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy's Health Services Administration program. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits toward a Bachelor's Degree; course grades must be a C or better. If admitted under the MCC-Detroit Mercy Health Service Administration Articulation Agreement, students may transfer an additional 24 credits, for a total of 87 transferrable credits. Additional courses not on this guide may also transfer.

This is a two-page document outlining courses that fulfill Detroit Mercy Core Curriculum and Health Services Administration program requirements.
