If admitted under the MCC-Detroit Mercy Digital Media Studies Articulation Agreement, students may transfer an additional 19 credits, for a total of 82 transferrable credits. * Students may select specific Detroit Mercy courses that fulfill the two Theory and Criticism courses that also may be used as OB5C and OB6B. Therefore, it is recommended to take specific OB5C and OB6B courses at Detroit Mercy.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 2.0 GPA based on 24 or more credits earned at MCC (and/or other accredited institutions).
- If less than 24 credits have been earned, a student's high school transcript is required.
