In order to apply to the Detroit Mercy Physician Assistant program, undergraduate students from Detroit Mercy must follow application guidelines including (but not limited to): at least 1000 hours of hands-on health care experience, all designated coursework completed (as outlined by the department), and a letter of recommendation from a biology faculty member.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum 2.50 GPA based on 24 or more credits earned at Mott CC (and/or other accredited institutions). Physician Assistant programs typically require a much higher GPA both overall and in the sciences.
- If less than 24 credits have been earned, a student's high school transcript is required.
- Apply for admission to Detroit Mercy at udmercy.edu/apply; the application is free.
