The following courses will transfer into Detroit Mercy's Accounting and Business Administration programs. Students may transfer a maximum of 63 credits towards a Bachelor's Degree; course grades must be a C or better. Additional courses not on this guide may also transfer.

- Minimum 2.50 GPA based on 24 or more credits earned at OCC (and/or other accredited institutions).
